That means it's time to make sure your Tabitha Boutique items are on track to be ready for bible school – even if that means starting now! 😊

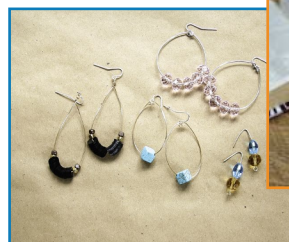
What *is* the Tabitha Boutique?
